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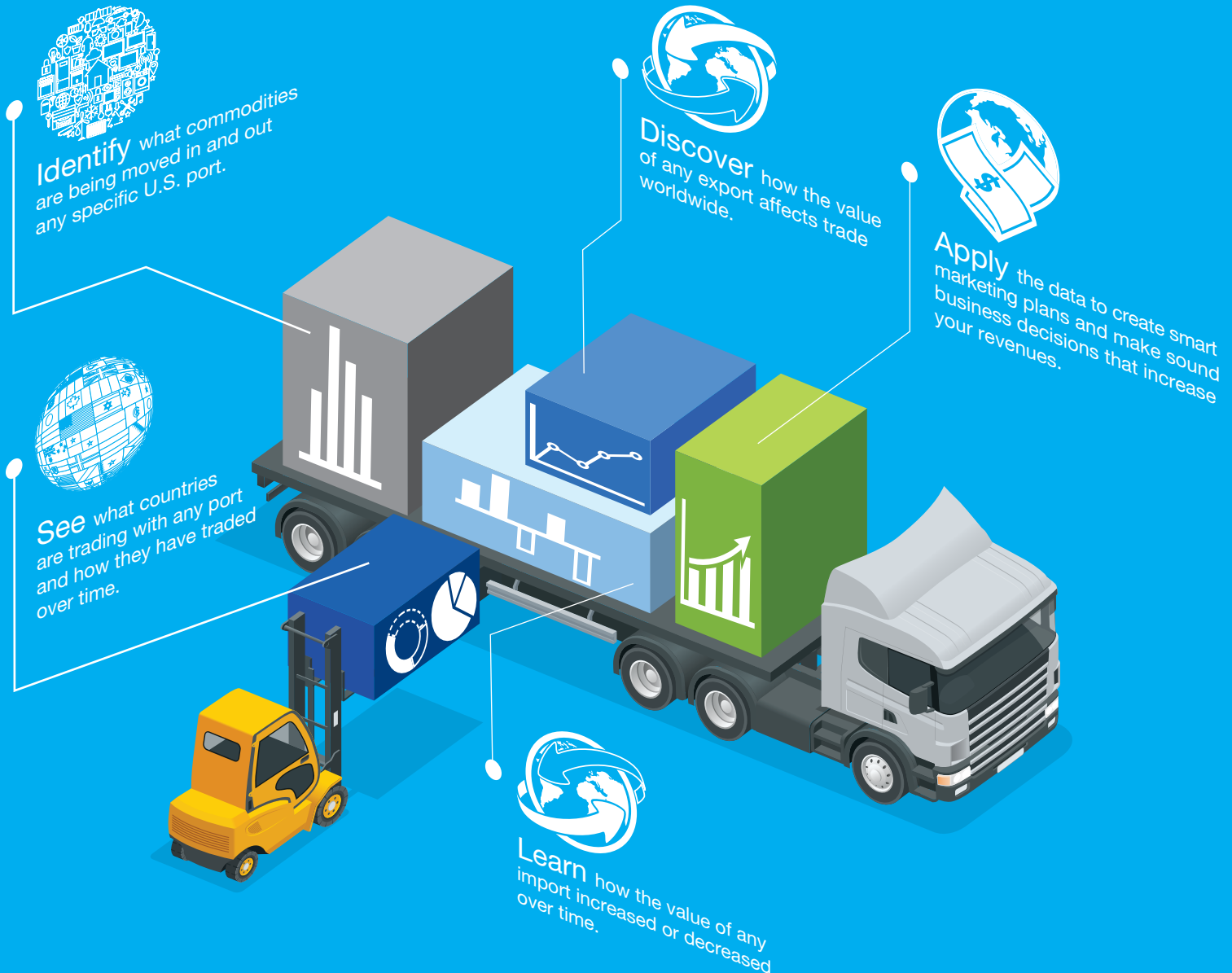

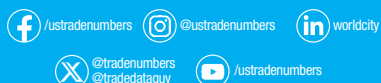
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Almost a record

Pharr tops \$46 billion in trade again

Pharr export-import trade increased to \$46.35 billion in 2024, missing a record by the slimmest of margins, 0.11 percent. While it was not a great year for exports, down 10.08 percent, it was a strong year for imports, which gained 7.73 percent.

On the export side, the top two exports, highly price-sensitive refined petroleum and natural gas, tumbled, though both are largely shipped to Mexico via pipeline rather than across the Pharr International Bridge. Medical instruments, chicken and other poultry, and miscellaneous plastic articles all

increased more than 40 percent. Another three in the top 25 increased more than 20 percent, parts for electrical supplies, passenger vehicles and plastic tubes.

But the action in 2024 was on the import side. For the first time, eight commodities surpassed \$1 billion each. Five set records, including No. 1 avocados, which crossed \$2 billion for the first time, insulated wire and cable, medical instruments, berries and motor vehicle parts.

For the seventh year in the last nine, Pharr ranked No. 30 among the nation's hundreds of airports, seaports and border crossings,

slipping to No. 31 in the pandemic years of 2020 and 2021. Along the U.S.-Mexico border, Pharr ranks fourth, trailing only Port Laredo, the Ysleta-Zaragoza Bridge at El Paso, and the border crossing in Otay Mesa, California.

With four consecutive years of trade above \$40 billion, including three straight years above \$45 billion, with additional bridge lanes coming on-line, with continuing infrastructure enhancements, and more private sector investment in industrial space, Pharr is one or two good years away from \$50 billion in two-way trade.

Casi un récord Pharr vuelve a superar los \$46 mil millones en comercio

El comercio de exportación e importación de Pharr aumentó a \$46.35 mil millones en 2024, pero por un margen mínimo de 0.11 por ciento no alcanzó el récord de 2022. Aunque no fue un gran año para las exportaciones, cayeron un 10.08 por ciento, fue un año fuerte para las importaciones, que aumentaron un 7.73 por ciento.

Con respeto a las exportaciones, las dos principales, el petróleo refinado y el gas natural, muy susceptibles a los precios, se desplomaron, aunque ambas se envían principalmente a México a través de oleoductos en lugar de a través del Puente Internacional de Pharr. Los instrumentos médicos, el pollo y otras aves de corral y diversos

artículos de plástico aumentaron más del 40 por ciento. Otras tres de los 25 principales aumentaron más del 20 por ciento: piezas para suministros eléctricos, vehículos de pasajeros y tubos de plástico.

Pero la acción en 2024 se dio en el lado de las importaciones. Por primera vez, ocho productos básicos superaron los \$1 mil millones cada uno. Cinco récords establecidos, incluidos los aguacates número 1, que superaron los \$2 mil millones por primera vez, cables y alambres aislados, instrumentos médicos, bayas y piezas de vehículos de motor.

Por séptima vez en los últimos nueve años, Pharr ocupó el puesto número 30 entre los cientos de aeropuertos, puertos marítimos y cruces

fronterizos del país, cayendo al puesto número 31 en los años de pandemia de 2020 y 2021. A lo largo de la frontera entre Estados Unidos y México, Pharr ocupa el cuarto lugar, solo detrás de Port Laredo, el puente Ysleta-Zaragoza en El Paso y el cruce fronterizo en Otay Mesa, California.

Con cuatro años consecutivos de comercio por encima de los \$40 mil millones, incluidos tres años consecutivos por encima de los \$45 mil millones, con carriles adicionales en progreso, con carriles de puentes adicionales en funcionamiento, con mejoras de infraestructura y más inversión del sector privado en espacio industrial, Pharr está a uno o dos buenos años de los \$50 mil millones en comercio bidireccional. 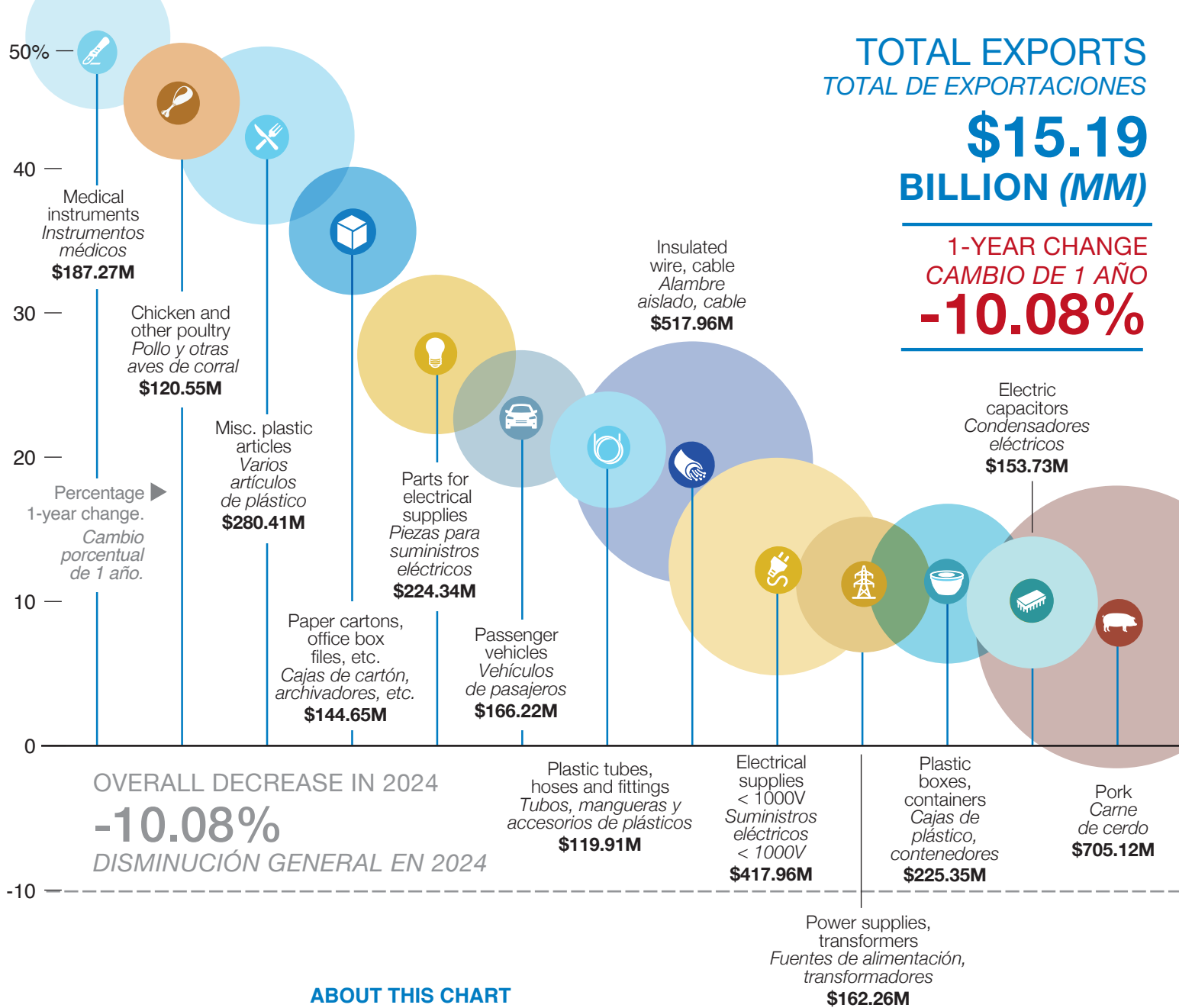

EXPORTS DROP BUT 19 PERFORM ABOVE AVERAGE

Pharr's exports fell 10.08 percent but 19 of its top 25 commodities performed above average (at left), with 12 registering double-digit growth and two even losing value.

The problem was that refined petroleum and natural gas, largely shipped via pipeline rather than trucked, suffered steep declines (below), distorting the picture somewhat.

LAS EXPORTACIONES CAEN PERO 19 TIENEN UN DESEMPEÑO SUPERIOR AL PROMEDIO

Las exportaciones de Pharr cayeron un 10.08 por ciento, pero 19 de sus 25 principales productos tuvieron un desempeño superior al promedio (a la izquierda), 12 registraron un crecimiento de doble dígito y dos incluso perdieron valor. El problema fue que el petróleo refinado y el gas natural, transportados en gran medida por gasoductos en lugar de camiones, sufrieron pronunciadas caídas (abajo), lo que distorsiona un poco el panorama.

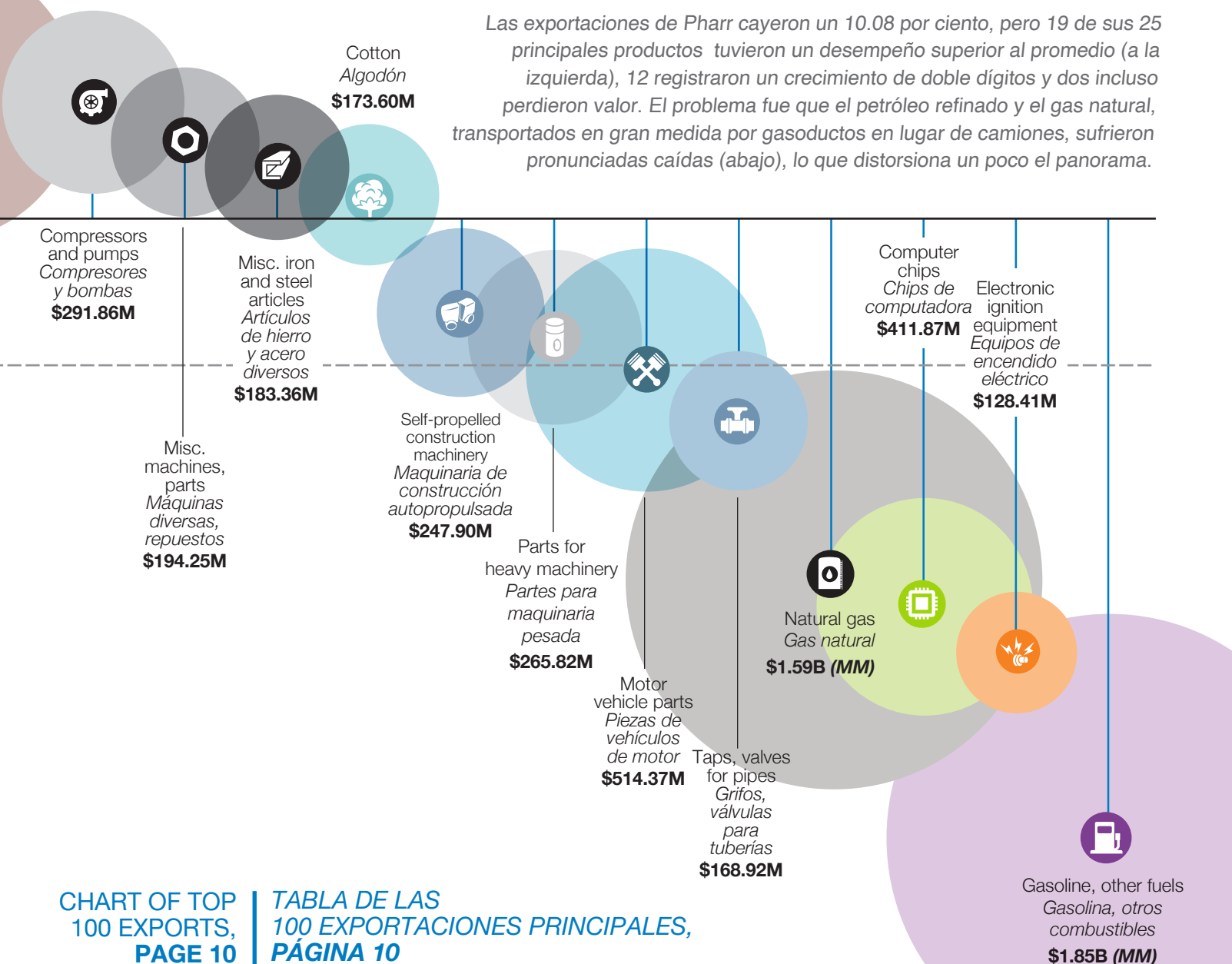

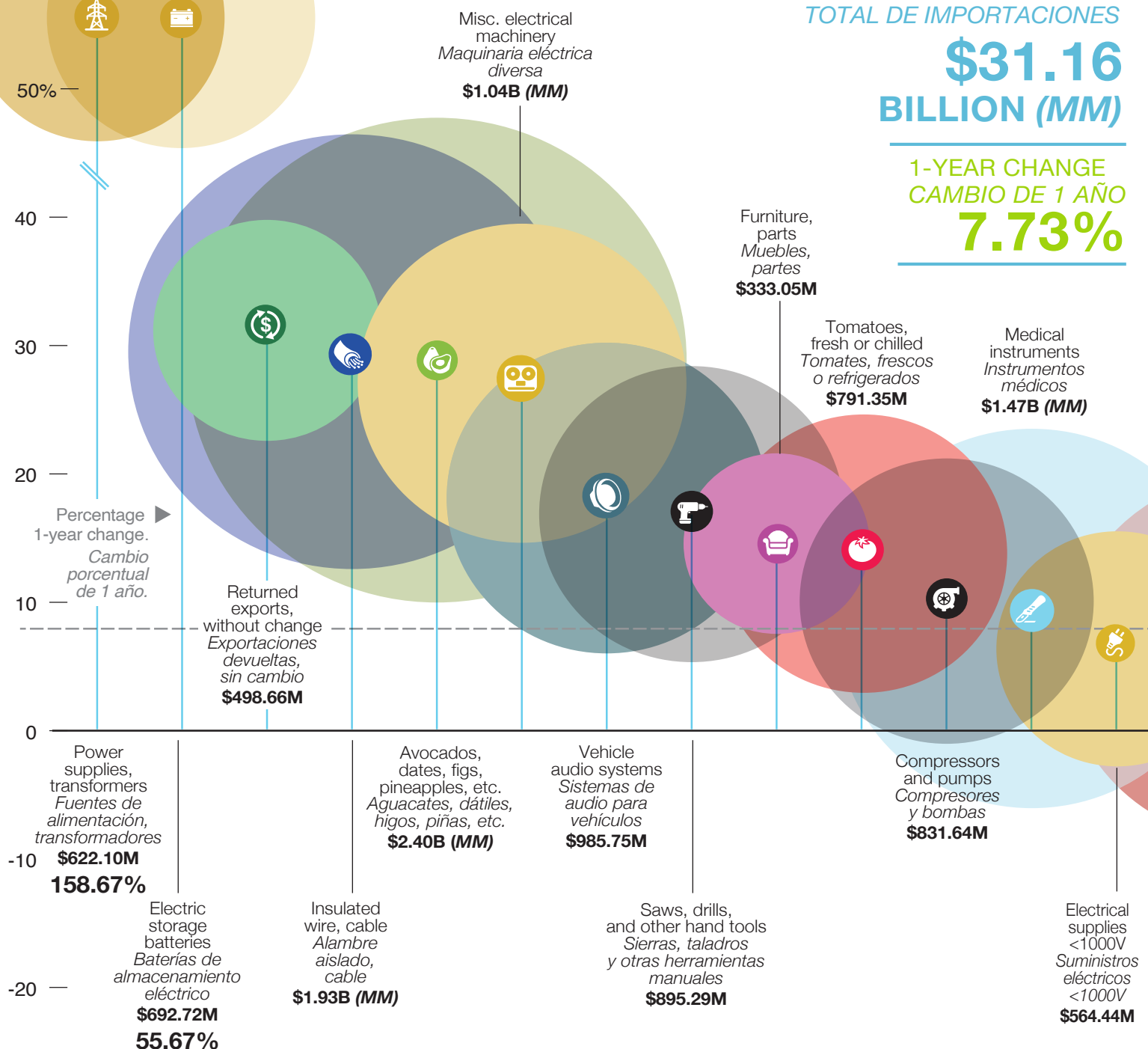

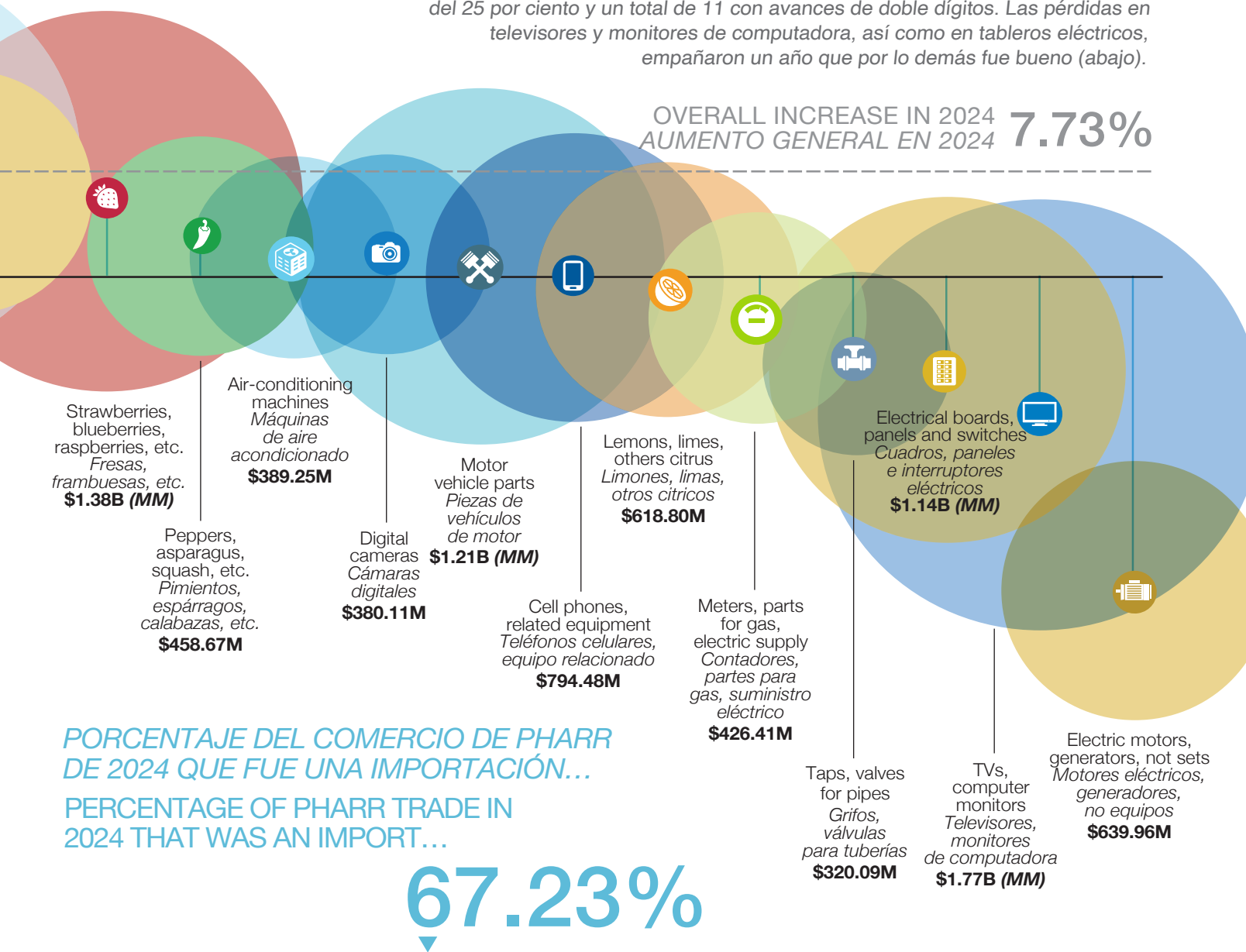
IMPORTS GAIN A SOLID 7.73 PERCENT IN 2024

Led by power supplies and transformers (at left), imports posted strong gains in 2024, with six gaining more than 25 percent and a total of 11 in double-digits. Losses in TVs and computer monitors as well as electrical boards tarnished an otherwise good year (below).
