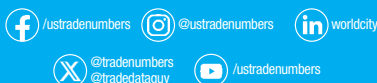

# a BIG year

## 2026 a pivotal year for Mexico, Pharr

### President's Note

Ken Roberts



Mexico completed a trifecta in 2025. For the first time ever, it was the United States' top trade partner, top export partner and top import partner.

The last time any nation ranked first in all three was in 2006, when Canada did so.

In recent years, China and Mexico have ranked first for two of the three – total trade and total imports. But, until last year, Canada had held on to the top spot for purchases of U.S. exports for more than three decades.

For Pharr and the other cities along

the U.S.-Mexico border in Texas, New Mexico, Arizona and California, Mexico's heightened importance is good news. Beyond the private-sector benefits – hotel stays, restaurant meals, gasoline sales and more – the tolls collected from all those trucks enrich local government budgets, keeping taxes lower than they would otherwise be and helping fund services that might not otherwise exist.

That's not a bad way to think about those 18-wheelers rumbling up and down Interstate 69C and Interstate 2, flush with berries or pork, avocados or

vehicle audio systems, particle board or wallpaper, tomatoes or broccoli. Think of them as a tax break, as enhanced city services.

2026 should be an important year for Pharr and the other cities along the border as Mexico, the United States and Canada enter into the six-year USMCA review, as Mexico closes in on China for the size of its deficit with the United States, as Pharr and other cities along the border work to increase and often double the lanes of their bridges.

## 2026: un año crucial para México y Pharr

México logró una triple hazaña en 2025. Por primera vez en la historia, se convirtió en el principal socio comercial, el principal destino de exportaciones y el principal proveedor de importaciones de los Estados Unidos.

La última vez que una nación ocupó el primer lugar en las tres categorías fue en 2006, cuando Canadá lo logró.

En los últimos años, China y México han ocupado el primer puesto en dos de las tres categorías: comercio total e importaciones totales. Sin embargo, hasta el año pasado, Canadá había mantenido la primera posición en cuanto a la compra de exportaciones estadounidenses durante más de tres décadas.

Para Pharr y las demás ciudades situadas a lo largo de la frontera entre Estados Unidos y México –en Texas, Nuevo México, Arizona y California–, la importancia de México constituye una excelente noticia. Más allá de los beneficios para el sector privado –estancias hoteleras, comidas en restaurantes, ventas de gasolina y otros rubros–, los peajes recaudados de todos esos camiones enriquecen los presupuestos de los gobiernos locales; esto permite mantener los impuestos más bajos de lo que serían de otro modo y ayuda a financiar servicios que, de no ser por ello, tal vez no existirían.

No es una mala manera de concebir a esos camiones de 18 ruedas que circulan ruidosamente por la Interestatal 69C y la Interestatal 2, cargados

hasta el tope de bayas o carne de cerdo, aguacates o sistemas de audio para vehículos, cablearía, paneles eléctricos, tomates o brócoli. Visualice a esos camiones como una desgravación fiscal; véalos como una mejora en los servicios de la ciudad.

El año 2026 promete ser un año trascendental para Pharr y las demás ciudades fronterizas, a medida que México, Estados Unidos y Canadá inician el proceso de revisión sexenal del T-MEC; a medida que México se acerca cada vez más a China en lo que respecta al volumen de su déficit comercial con Estados Unidos; y a medida que Pharr y otras ciudades de la frontera trabajan para ampliar –y, en muchos casos, duplicar– el número de carriles en sus puentes internacionales.

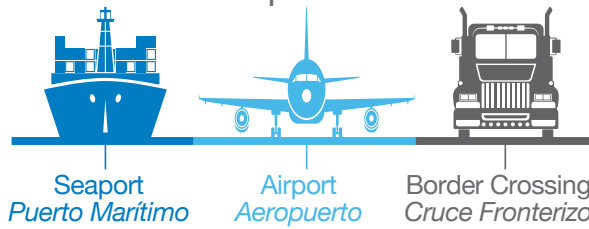

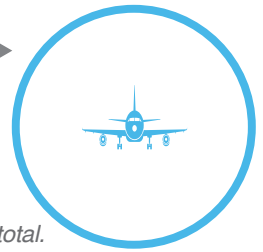

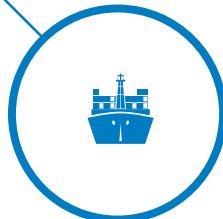

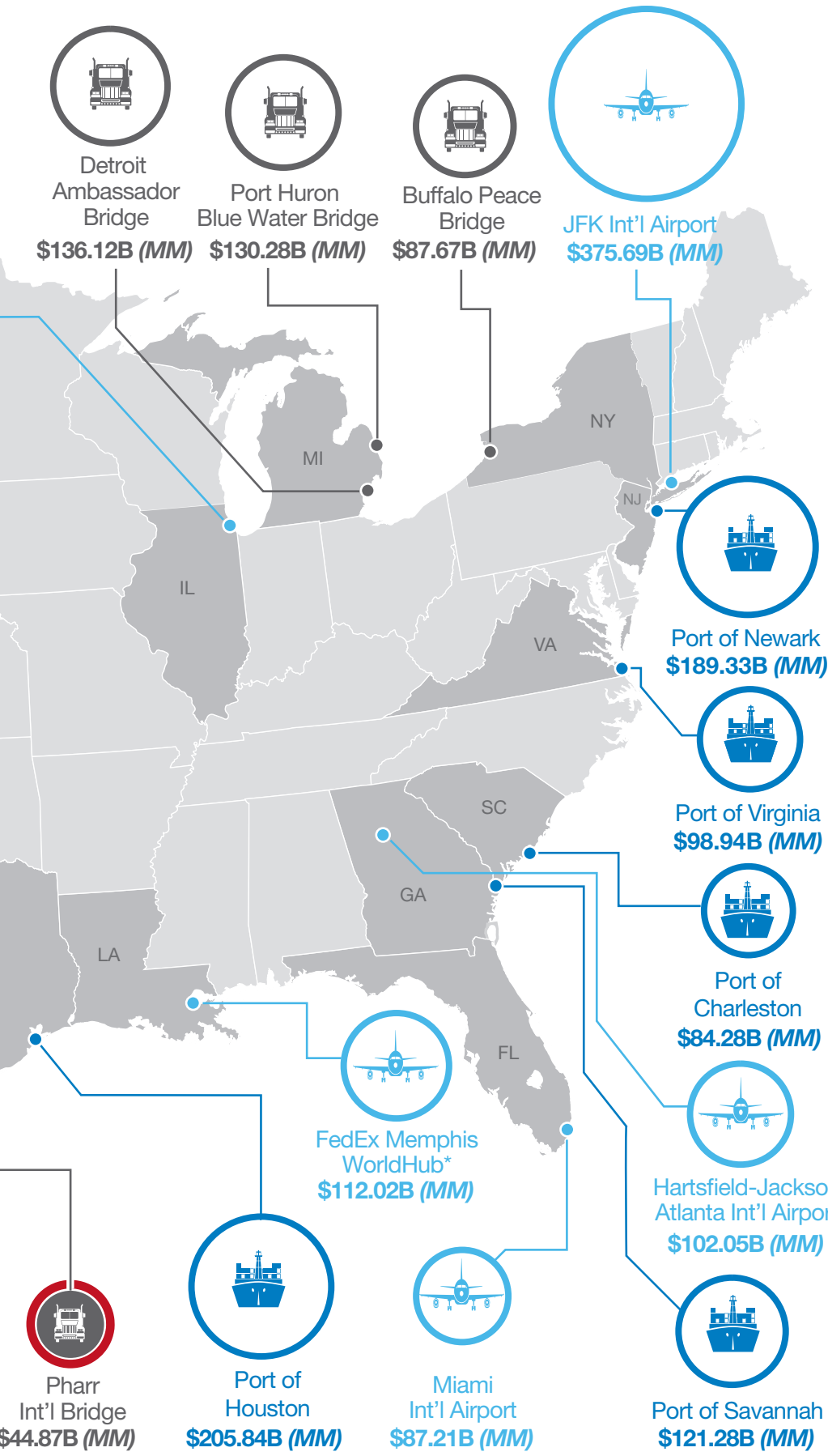

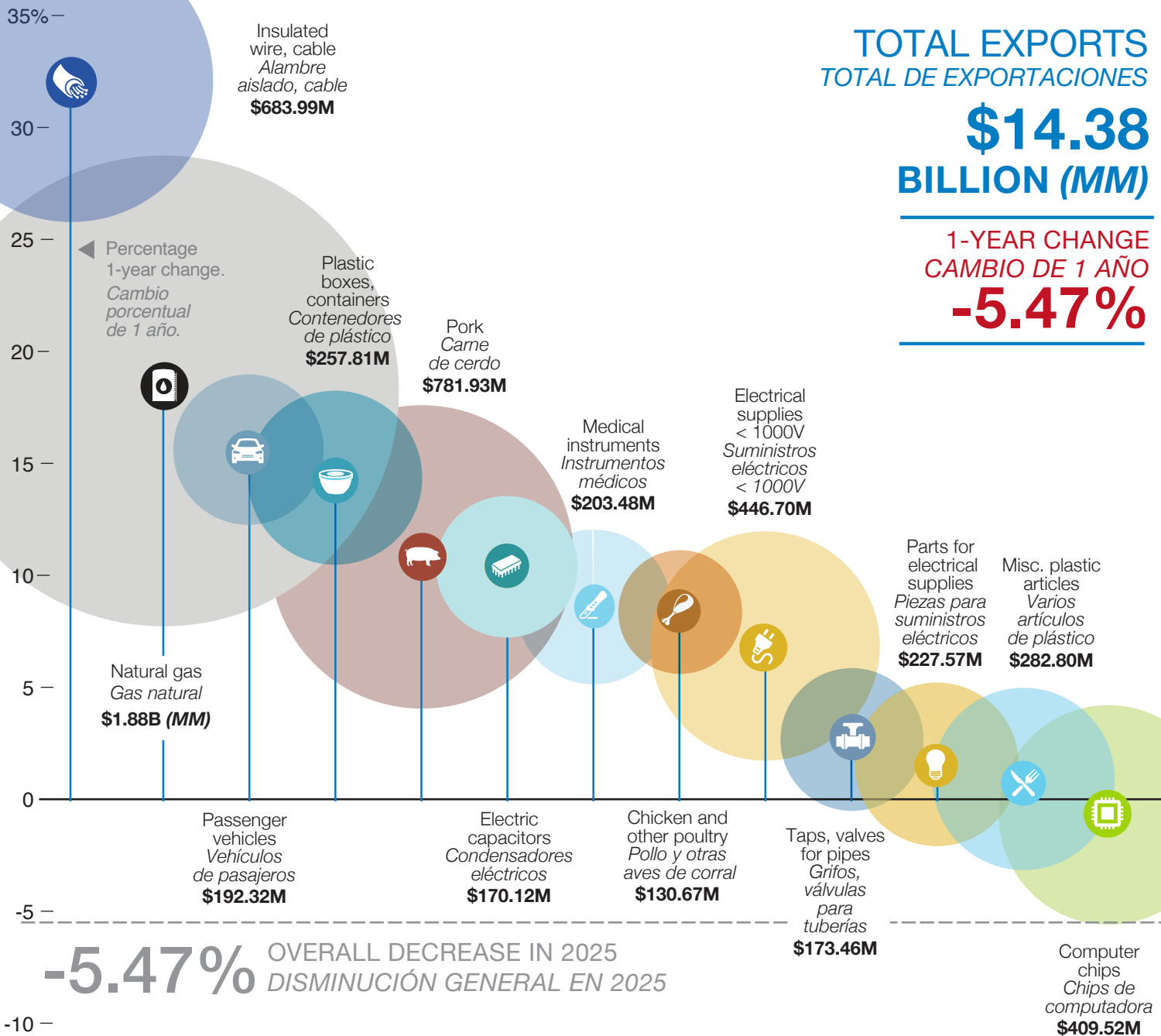

# 2025 PACE OF CHANGE RITMO DEL CAMBIO

## Gasoline, other exports decline in 2025

Pharr's fastest-growing exports among its top 25 were insulated wire and cable and natural gas, shown on the left, followed by passenger vehicles and plastic containers. Those gains were weighted down by loses in the gasoline and other refined petroleum products, seen at the far right below.

## Gasolina y otras exportaciones decreció en 2025

Las exportaciones de Pharr con el crecimiento más acelerado —dentro de su lista de las 25 principales— fueron los cables y alambres aislados y el gas natural (mostrados a la izquierda), seguidos por los vehículos de pasajeros y contenedores de plástico. Estos avances se vieron neutralizados por las pérdidas en el sector de la gasolina y otros productos refinados del petróleo, tal como se observa en el extremo derecho de la parte inferior.

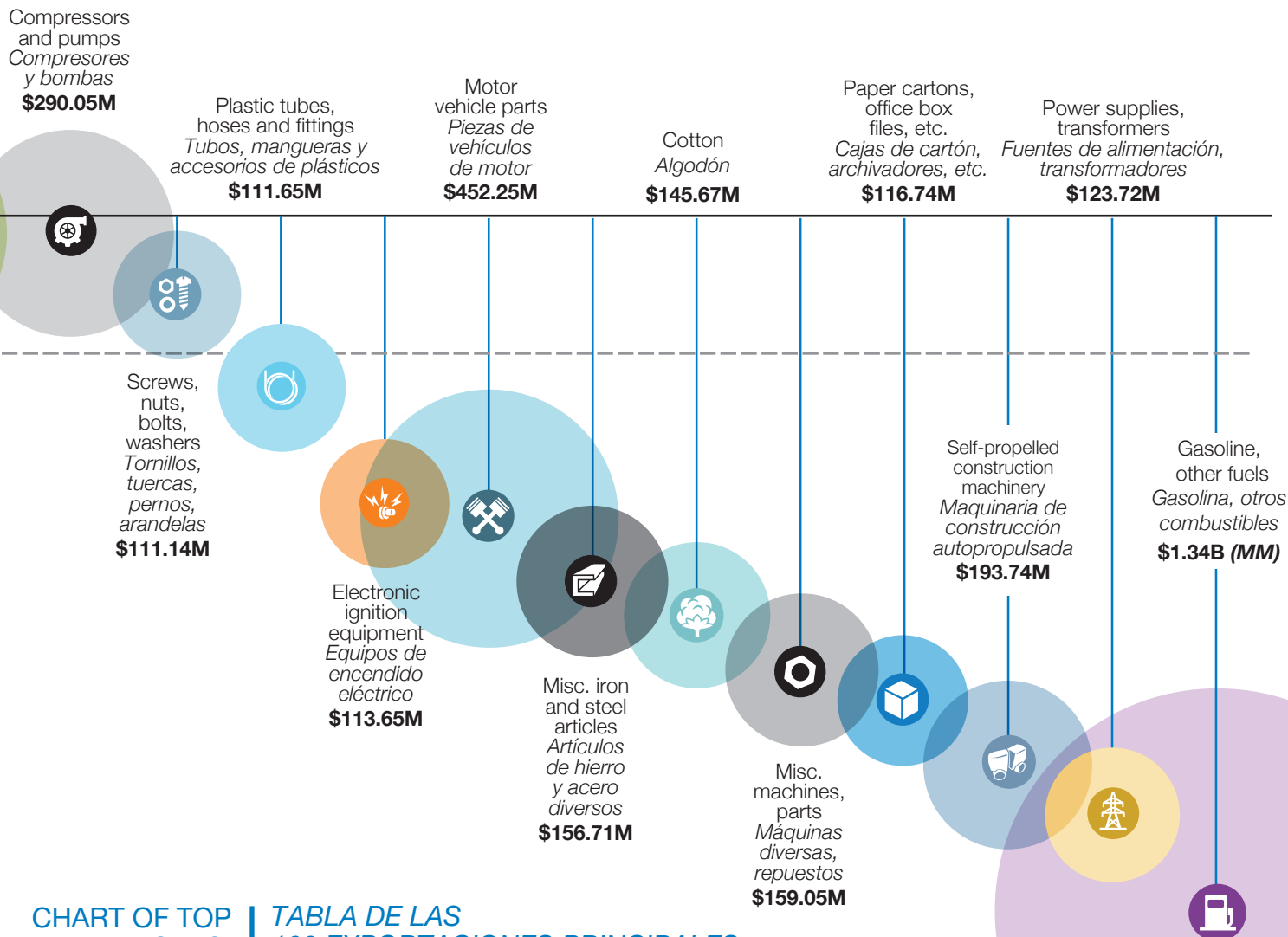


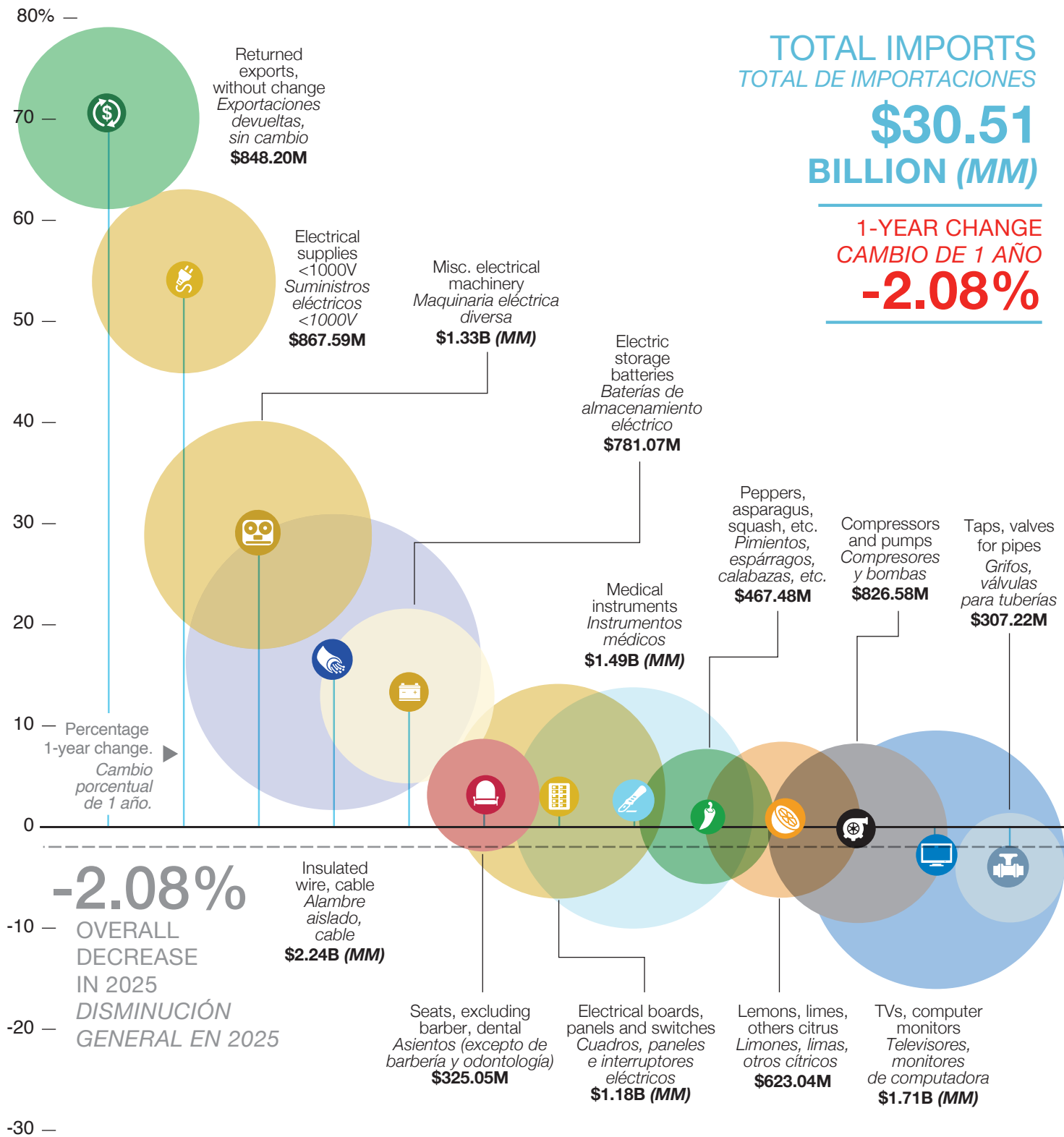

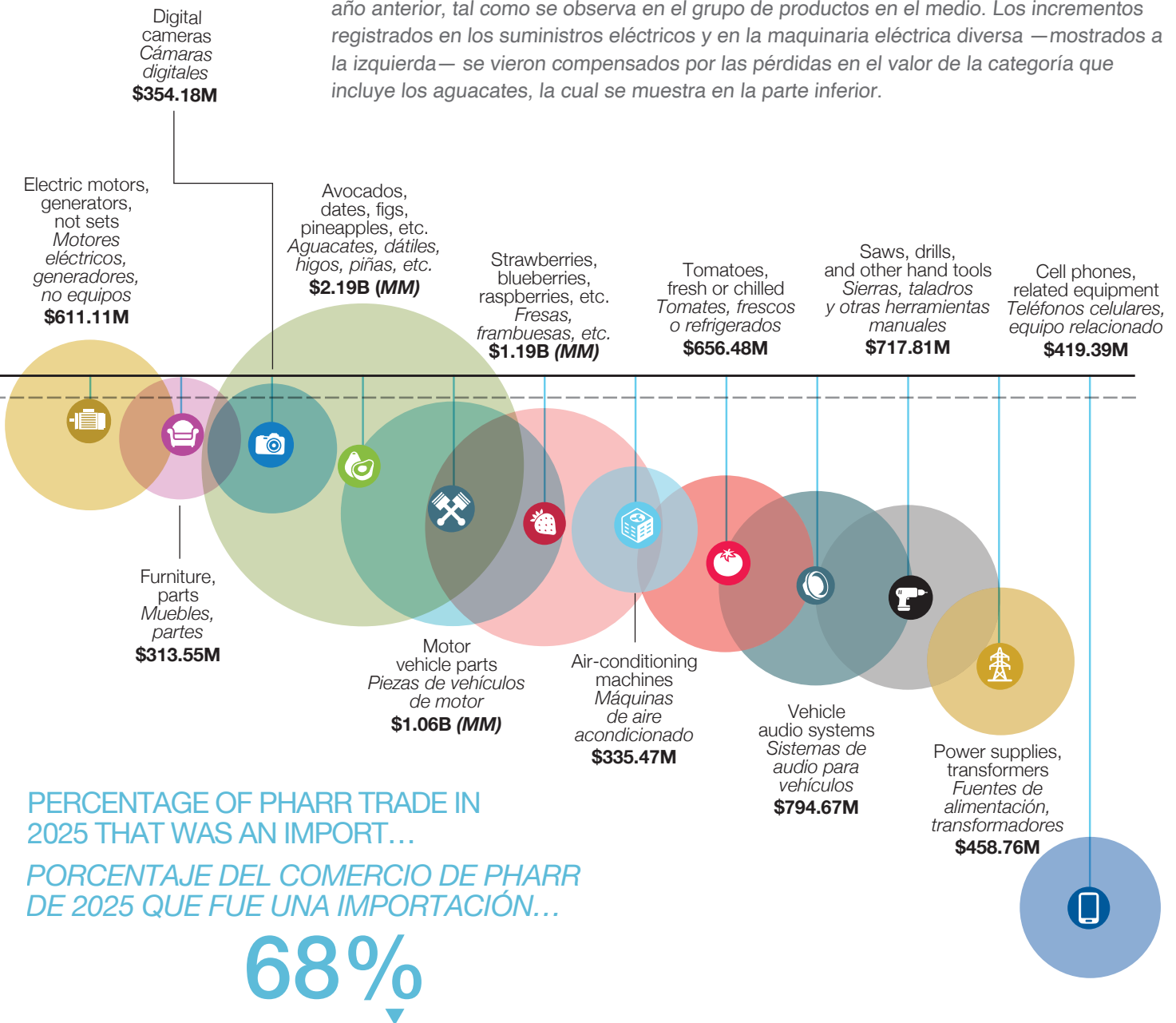

## Less avocados, more technology

Nine of the top 25 imports rose or fell less than 5 percent from the previous year, as shown by the large group in the middle. Gains by electrical supplies and miscellaneous electrical machinery, shown at left, were offset by losses in the value of the category that included avocados, shown below.

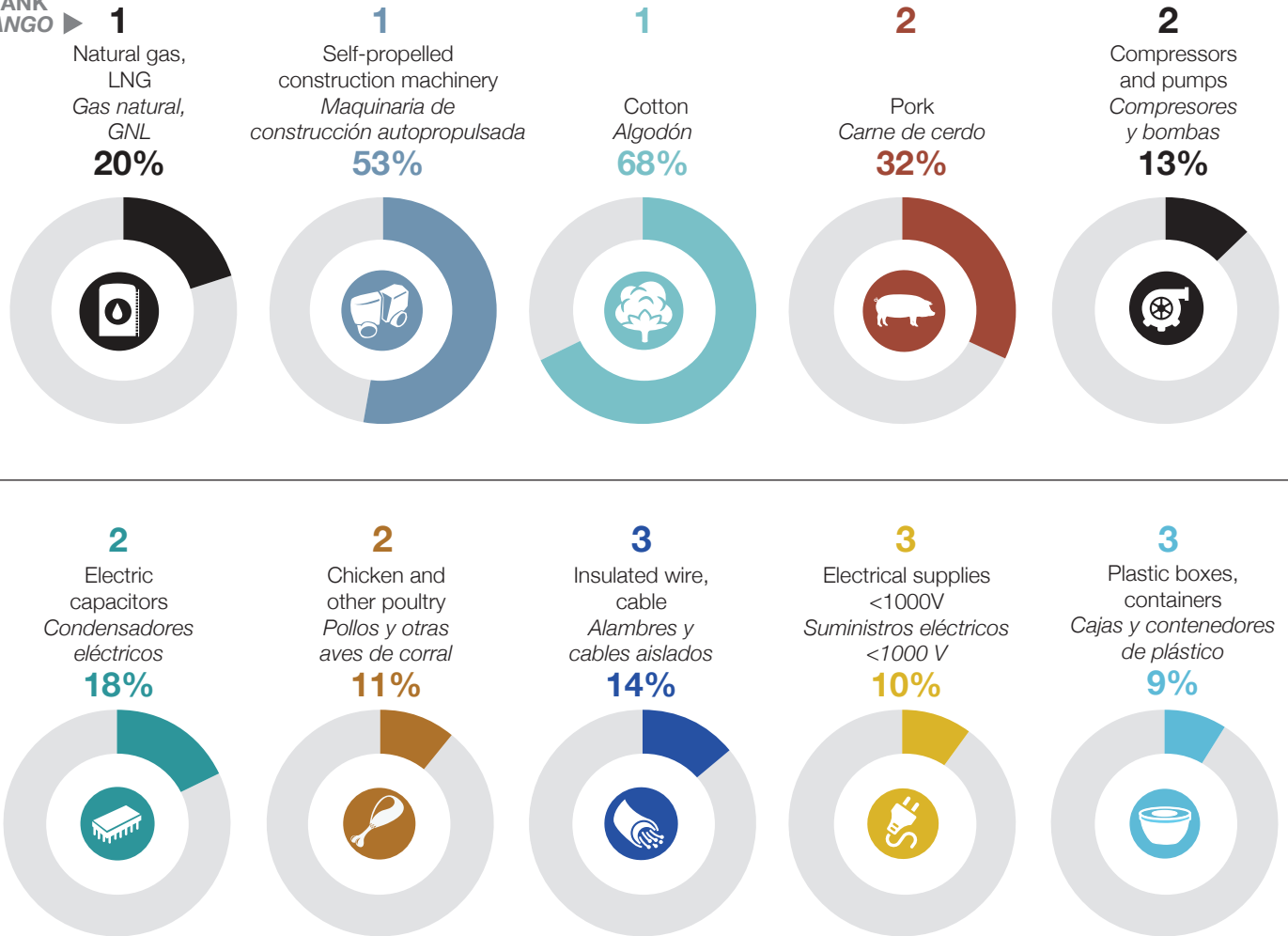

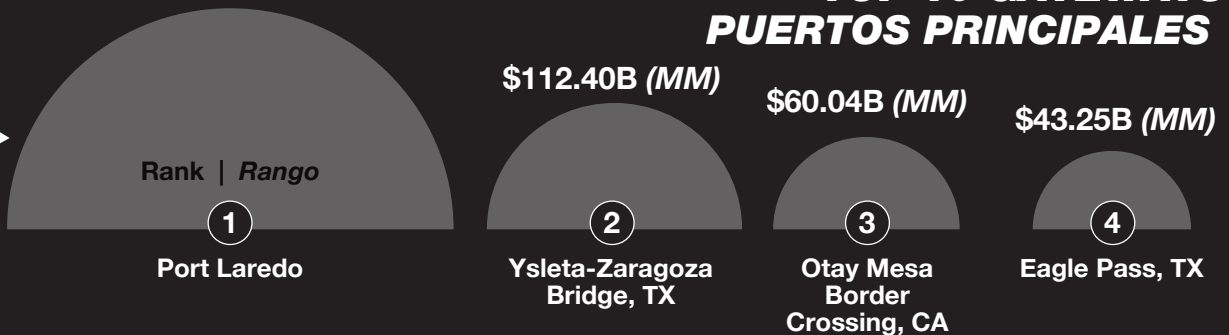
